The Twenty-Seventh Annual Western International Walking Horse Show **will be held on the grounds of the Oregon Horse Center, near Eugene, Oregon** September 25th- 27th, 2009. www.oregonhorsecenter.com
Regular halter classes are scheduled for Friday, September 25th.
WIWHA Futurity halter classes begin at 1:30 p.m. and the under saddle classes at 7:00 pm on Saturday, September 26.

When you nominate and show in the Western International Futurity, your colt or filly will have the advantage of having been socialized as a weanling, trailered, bathed, clipped and brushed and made more beautiful with creams, sprays, and gloss. Your young horse will have taken a first step in being a well rounded horse!

NOTE: Rule update per November 2006 meeting regarding nomination of yearlings, two year olds or three year olds that missed a year. If your horse missed a year in nominations you may make up the nominations and compete in the current year. Following are the conditions and fines:

- 1. Horse must have been nominated and paid as a weanling.**
- 2. Horse must make up each years nomination at double the rate plus a \$50.00 fine. (If you missed nominating as a yearling you will owe \$100.00 for the missed yearling year, \$50.00 and the regular rate for the two year old year. If you missed 2 years, yearling and two year old you will owe \$200.00 plus the fee for the three year old year. If you did NOT nominate the horse as a WEANLING then your horse is NOT eligible to make up the any missed years.**

A parade of Futurity Halter winners (first and second places) is scheduled for Saturday evening and includes two and three year old halter winners. No parade of Futurity stallions is planned.

Weanlings must have their dam and sire nominated their weanling year. The owner of the stallion usually pays fees for the stallion, however anyone may pay the fee for the sire or dam. If you sell your nominated colt, the nomination follows the sale and qualifies the colt for the next year's nomination and futurity. We accept nominations from any State, but blanks will be mailed to Idaho, Nevada, Oregon and Washington members.

REGARDING YOUTH CLASSES. We will NOT be offering Youth Futurity Halter this year.

Records and copies of papers for nominated Weanlings are maintained in the office. Please mail a copy of the weanling's registration papers with the nomination. We will have a copy machine in the office at the show and can make copies of the original if needed. If your registration papers have not been returned from the Breeders' Association, mark your nomination form '**applied for**' where the registration number is required. If you have received a blood typing kit or a DNA kit, it will contain the name and number assigned by the Breeders' Association. You can make a copy of that label and mail it with your nomination form. If you did not mail a copy of your weanling's papers last year, please send us a copy this year. Yearlings without copies of papers cannot be shown. If you have a problem, please call and we will assist in any way that we can.

Please mail the nomination form to us with your check made payable to WIWHA FUTURITY. Show entry blanks to reserve stalls for your futurity nominated entry should be mailed to the Show Secretary after you receive the regular show premium.

ENTRIES CLOSE for the Futurity, September 5th, 2009 to allow time to check entries, registration numbers and to allow time to get the information ready for the program. If you have questions unanswered in the General Provisions, please email Linda Arnold. If you know of anyone who has purchased a weanling or horse, and should be on our mailing list, please advise us and we will mail a form and show premium. ***Please do not send Futurity checks to the show secretary.***

The Western International Walking Horse Association Futurity offers four divisions. A foal must be nominated as a weanling and is eligible through the three-year-old year, providing all Futurity conditions are met. A foal need not be shown in any given year to maintain eligibility so long as all other conditions are met. Please read the conditions carefully.

NOTE: Rule update per November 2006 meeting regarding nomination of yearlings, two year olds or three year olds that missed a year. If your horse missed a year in nominations you may make up the nominations and compete in the current year. Following are the conditions and fines:

1. Horse and its sire and dam must have been nominated and paid as a weanling.

2. Horse must make up each years nomination at double the rate plus a \$50.00 late fee.

Example: If you have a two year old and missed nominating as a yearling you will owe \$100.00 for the missed yearling year, \$50.00 for the late fee and the regular rate of \$30.00 (each class) for the two year old year. If you missed 2 years, yearling and two year old you will owe \$250.00 plus the fees for the three year old year. If you did NOT nominate the horse as a WEANLING then your horse is NOT eligible to make up the any missed years

WHAT COLTS AND FILLIES ARE ELIGIBLE

A foal, to be eligible, must be registered (or in the process of being registered) with the Tennessee Walking Horse Breeders' and Exhibitors' Association. The foal must be nominated and all fees paid to the WIWHA Futurity, by the closing date in its weanling year. It's sire and dam must also be nominated and fees paid by this date.

Colts and fillies nominated as weanlings in a Regional Futurity or the National Futurity are eligible when purchased by an owner residing in another Regional Futurity area, to show in a Regional Futurity of the owner's choice, as long as all applicable nomination fees are paid when the colt or filly is moved and entered. A colt or filly can only be nominated in one Regional Futurity. No cross entries are allowed from one region to another. Also, horses that have maintained their eligibility as yearlings, two and three year olds can transfer their eligibility to the Regional Futurity area nearest the owner's place of residence or the Regional Futurity of the owner's choice. The eligibility privilege does not apply to buy-in colts and fillies.

NOMINATION OF SIRE

To nominate a stallion in the Futurity it is necessary that: (1) the stallion be registered with the Tennessee Walking Horse Breeders' and Exhibitors' Association, and (2) a fee of \$50 be paid to the Futurity on or before the closing date in the foal's weanling year. Any person may nominate and pay the nomination fees for the sire. If the Sire fee is not paid the weanling will not be eligible for the futurity.

NOMINATION OF DAM

To nominate a mare for the Futurity it is necessary that: (1) the mare be registered with the Tennessee Walking Horse Breeders' and Exhibitors' Association, and (2) a fee of \$20 be paid to the Futurity on or before the closing date in the foal's weanling year. Any person may nominate and pay the nomination fees for the dam.

THE WEANLING DIVISION

In order for a foal to be eligible to show in the Weanling Division of the Futurity, the following conditions must be met:

- 1) The sire and dam of the foal must be registered with the TWHBEA.
- 2) The sire and dam must have been nominated in the foal's weanling year.
- 3) The foal must be registered or registration applied for.
- 4) All foals, whether born or not, must be nominated by the Futurity closing date in the foal's weanling year and a \$30 fee must be paid to the Futurity. Foals born October through December, may be considered weanlings the following year. The nominating fee for foals born after the closing date, may be rebated upon presentation of a veterinarian's certification of a stillbirth or birth deformity.
- 5) Entries in the Division will be shown in hand, in a show halter: a. Colts/Geldings, b. Fillies. There will not be a Youth Division this year.
- 6) Ribbons will be given to ten places and money to ten places.

THE YEARLING DIVISION

In order for a colt, filly, or gelding to be eligible to show in the Yearling Division of the Futurity, the following conditions must be met:

- 1) The colt, filly or gelding must have been entered in the Weanling Division of a Futurity and all conditions and requirements of that Division must have been fulfilled including registration.
- 2) \$30 must be paid to the Futurity on or before the closing date of the year the entry becomes a yearling.
- 3) Entries in the Division will be shown in hand, in a bridle or show halter: a. Colts /Geldings, b. Fillies. There will not be a Youth Division this year.
- 4) Ribbons will be given to ten places and money to ten places.

THE TWO-YEAR-OLD DIVISION

In order for a colt, filly or gelding to be eligible to show in the Two-Year-Old Division of the Futurity, the following conditions must be met:

- 1) The colt, filly or gelding must have been entered in the Weanling and Yearling Divisions of a Futurity and all conditions and requirements of those divisions must have been fulfilled.
- 2) \$30 must be paid to the Futurity for each division on or before the closing date of the year the entry becomes a two-year-old.
- 3) Entries in this Division will be shown: (1) Under Saddle, a. Show, b. Plantation or Lite Shod, Open English or Western c. Trail Pleasure or Country Pleasure Amateur, English or Western. No Cross entries. (2) In hand in a bridle or show halter English or Western. Colts, Geldings and Fillies from all divisions will be shown together.
- 4) Ribbons to ten places and Money to five places.

THE THREE-YEAR-OLD DIVISION

In order for a colt, filly or gelding to be eligible to show in the Three-Year-old Division of the Futurity, the following conditions must be met:

- 1) The colt, filly or gelding must have been entered in the Weanling, Yearling and TwoYear-old Divisions of a Futurity and all conditions and requirements of those divisions must have been fulfilled.
- 2) \$30 must be paid to the Futurity for each division on or before the closing date of the year the entry becomes a three-year-old.
- 3) (3) Entries in this Division will be shown: (1) Under Saddle, a. Show, b. Plantation or Lite Shod, Open, English or Western. c. Trail Pleasure or Country Pleasure Amateur, English or Western. No cross entries. (2) In hand in a bridle or show halter English or Western. Colts, Geldings and Fillies from all divisions will be shown together.
- 4) Ribbons to ten places and Money to five places.

NOTE: When showing in halter and under saddle, a Nomination fee must be paid for each class. Please specify which class on the WIWHA show entry blank.

PRIZES

1. The nominator of the dam of the winning filly foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$35.00. The nominator of the dam of the second place filly foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$20.00
 2. The nominator of the dam of the winning colt foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$35.00. The nominator of the dam of the second place colt foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$20.00.
 3. The nominator of the sire of the winning filly in the Weanling Division will receive \$40. The nominator of the sire of the second place filly foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$20.00
 4. The nominator of the sire of the winning colt foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$40.00. The nominator of the sire of the second place colt foal in the Weanling division will receive \$20.00
 5. The value of the prize fund of the Futurity each year shall be the total amount of the money paid in fees, miscellaneous funds and added donations minus necessary administrative expenses. Each year, the specific awards to the nominators of the sires and dams will be deducted before the division of the prize funds among the four divisions. The Futurity committee reserves the right to allocate the division of special funds raised by the committee for the benefit of the Futurity.
6. Other Awards:
- Premier Sire** – Awarded to the stallion whose foals win the most points in this years Futurity classes.
 - Premier Dam** – Awarded to the mare whose foals win the most points in this year's Futurity classes.
 - Graduate Award** – Awarded to the Three Year Old amassing the most points in its futurity career.

FEES: Make All payments payable to WIWHA Futurity.

LATE FEES: ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER SEPTEMBER 5th 2008 (postmarked) WILL BE ASSESSED A \$10.00 PER HORSE. CHARGE DOES NOT APPLY TO SIRE OR DAM NOMINATION.

LIABILITY

No entry is liable for more than the amount of nomination fees, but there will be no return of a payment except as provided in Item 4 of the Weanling provisions. Right is reserved to reject any entry and to bar any entry from competition for failure to comply with the conditions of the Futurity and the rules of WIWHA and NHSRC.
