Enclosed please find the Show Schedule, Entry Form, and Rules & Regulations for the 2007 TWHEAO Summer Extravaganza.

What's New and Different and What's the Same -

- We are once again having the expanded trail class in the arena near the stalls.
- We will not be having the auction this year. In lieu of that we've rearranged the schedule so that we once again have a Saturday night schedule. We have filled Saturday night with several fun classes as well as a walking horse drill team exhibition.
- We plan to have an Exhibitor Appreciation BBQ. Some of the details are yet to be worked out – please check the club website www.twheao.com for more details and if you are a TWHEAO member, we'll send out an email notification.
- RV Spaces – these are to be reserved through the Oregon Horse Center **directly**. Rates are \$10 per night, no hookup and \$15 per night with electrical hook up. Email Julie Harper – julie@oregonhorsecenter.com
- Early Arrival and Late Stay are also through the Oregon Horse center **directly**. Contact Julie Harper at julie@oregonhorsecenter.com for additional information.
- All stalls (and tack) will come with 3 bales of shavings. The shavings will not be spread out. Should you need additional shavings, first use what came with your tack stall and as additional is needed there will be a designated area to pick up an additional bales. Each bale is 8 cubic feet.
- A few of the halter type classes have been combined. If entries warrant, we will consider splitting the class according to gender.
- We are finalizing our horse show photographer. Depending on who we obtain, we may end up charging a fee to offset costs associated with the photographer. If we do this, we are hoping to also provide exhibitors with a complimentary photo.
- Show Program – we do not currently have anyone available to make the show program. If you are interested in doing so Robyn has a template that can be used. Please contact Robyn directly at robyn@secureinnovation.com or (403) 356-4153 if you are interested. If someone volunteers the website will be updated and TWHEAO members will receive email notification.
- The Oregon Horse Center is a NON SMOKING facility. OHC will be enforcing this and has requested that TWHEAO also assist in enforcing this rule. Failure to abide by this regulation may result in fine of up to \$500 and/or cancellation of your entry and forfeiture of all fees paid and/or prize money earned.
- By signing the attached entry form you agree to abide by all rules and regulations listed in this premium.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

As with all shows, there are lots of duties and many are filled by our wonderful exhibitors – staffing is needed for Gate, Center Ring (helping hand out ribbons), and possibly DQP secretary. Also, a sign up sheet will be posted at the show as a reminder of what position and time slot you signed up for and to help fill any last minute slots.

HOTEL INFORMATION

A discounted rate has been obtained through Best Western, Grand Manor Inn located in Springfield. There are a limited number of rooms at the discounted rate. There is a combination of rooms with a king bed and rooms with two queens. Rates are between \$75 and \$90. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Should TWHEAO receive a bill for any early arrivals or late departures that were not collected, you will in turn be billed, along with a billing fee of \$30.00. By signing the entry form you agree to these rules.

- Stalls will have three bales (still in a bale) of shavings in them upon arrival and additional bales can be picked up from the designated area.
- Dogs accompanying exhibitors and trainers must be kept on a leash at all times, you must clean up after your pet, any complaints filed and you will be required to confine your dog.
- Trainers and exhibitors please keep the center aisle of barn free of tables and chairs, as this is used as an alley for entry into the warm up arena. We will require you to move any tables or chairs set in that area.
- The warm up arena is off limits for visitors. Please respect this.
- Parking in the unloading area is for loading and unloading only please keep your trucks in the general parking area or a tow truck may be called.
- Horses are only allowed in the barn/warm up arena and in the main arena.
- Please clean up after yourself and your horse. Areas left messy after the show will be charged to the organization and subsequently you will be billed whatever the facility charges (minimum of \$40), plus an additional billing fee of \$30.00.
- The facility monitors closely to ensure there is no smoking in the facility. Show management will assist in enforcing this. Anyone found smoking in the facility is subject to up to a \$500 fine and/or removal from the show.

ENTRY AND CLASS INFORMATION

- Entries must be postmarked and paid for by the closing date, **Wednesday, June 13, 2007**.
- Entries postmarked after the closing date, will be assessed late charges.
- For insurance purposes, all horses exhibited must have a stall. There will be no working out of trailers.
- Payment in full (or a signed blank check) must be included with the entry to cover all stalls and classes entered (checks will not be deposited until after the show to allow for scratched classes); show numbers will not be issued until the entry is complete.
- The Show Office reserves the right to check papers at this show. Therefore, bring your papers or a copy showing both sides, do not assume that copies are on file. (USDA requires you to have this information available if asked). If the horse is being leased, please bring your lease agreement.
- Show Management reserves the right to accept or refuse service and/or deny entries and/or cancel entries. Additionally, any individual who exhibit disorderly conduct or non sportsman like conduct may be asked to leave the grounds.
- All amateurs must present current amateur cards and WIWHA youth cards must be presented by all juvenile participants. WIWHA Amateur and Youth application forms will be available in the office.
- The trainer of the horse must sign all entries. If you do your own training you must sign as the trainer.
- To receive Pre-Entry refunds, a copy of the Veterinarian's certificate specifying the nature of disability accompanied by the bill for treatment. Fees not refunded will be calculated on a \$25.00 per stall, \$10.00 per entry basis with a maximum of \$35.00 retained.
- Persons failing to pay their bill in full and/or returned checks will be assessed a \$30.00 service fee. If not paid promptly, the bill will be turned over to Western International for collection. If not resolved, suspension will result and names may also be sent to the NHSC. Those on suspension will not be allowed to show at WIWHA or NHSC affiliated shows.
- Please list all riders for each horse on the entry form. If additional space is needed please attach form to the entry.
- All classes will be conducted by the rules of WIWHA/NHSC Rulebook and the TWHBEA Versatility Rulebook.
- All attempts will be made to combine one horse classes with other similar classes. However, management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class that has less than three (3) horses entered. Additionally, management reserves the right to run a one horse qualifying class as a Championship class, rather than have two, one horse classes.
- When classes are entered and the horse does not go in the class, the class must be paid for unless the class is canceled or a scratch slip is filled out and in the office before the class has been called by DQP. No refund for any class when the horse is excused by DQP, excused by the judge, or self-excused once you entered the ring.
- **Entries made while going through DQP or at the office once the session has started, rather than in advance of that session, will be assessed a \$10.00 per class fee, no exceptions**

- Gate holds (3 minute maximum) will be granted for just cause upon notification of the Paddock announcer.
- To qualify for a performance championship class, the horse must have been shown and judged in the matching qualifying class. Example – to qualify for the Plantation English 2 gait amateur championship, the horse must have been shown and judged in either the Plantation English 2 gait amateur or Plantation English 2 gait open. Additionally, Juvenile riders must qualify in Juvenile classes to compete in Juvenile Championships; any Championship class that does not have a qualifier is open to any entry. Cross entry: No cross entries between two and three gait championships with the same horse and rider combination.
- Trail Pleasure and Country Pleasure classes are Amateur Only. Trail Pleasure and Country Pleasure horses are not allowed to show in any other Liteshod or Plantation classes at the same show, but they are eligible to show in halter and versatility classes (trail, reining, driving, water glass)
- TWHBEA Pleasure classes are open to any flatshod horse (Trail Pleasure and Country Pleasure horses shall be ridden by an amateur or youth rider).
- All classes are exclusively for the registered Tennessee Walking Horse, with the exception of the Country Pleasure classes which are open to non-registered horses.
- 1st year showing – First year the rider has shown. Or first year the horse has shown.
- Maiden – Never have placed 1st in Trail or under saddle.
- Novice – not to have won more than three (3) blue ribbons at any affiliated show.
- Limit – not to have won more than six (6) blue ribbons at any affiliated show.
- OTR – Amateur Owner to Ride.
- The judge may grant time-outs when the exhibitor pulls into the center of the arena. Time-outs will be granted for replacement of shoes, replacement of broken equipment, or in other instances, where the judge finds valid reason. An exhibitor may be excused from the ring by pulling into the center of the arena and obtaining permission from the judge or ringmaster.
- WIWHA, The Tennessee Walking Horse Exhibitors Association of Oregon (TWHEAO), the TWHEAO Show Committee, and the Oregon Horse Center will not be responsible for any articles that may be lost, destroyed or stolen, although every precaution will be taken to protect property and exhibitors. The show or management will not be liable for any injury sustained in any way to exhibitors, animals, employees or spectators. The warm up arena is not open to visitors; you must be an owner, rider, trainer, or groom to be in the area. Management reserves the right to refuse entries or accept entries conditionally, to cancel entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel premiums without claims for damage.
- Year End High Points: You must be a member of the Oregon or Washington association to be eligible for Hi Points. Forms can be obtained ahead of time on the TWHEAO web site at www.twheao.com or on the Washington club site www.twhbeaofwa.com.
- Trophy and ribbons to five places in all classes. Trophy to first and ribbons to eight in championship classes. Championship winnings will be mailed out to owners of record, as stated on registration papers after the show bookkeeping is reconciled.
- Purse \$\$ will not be paid out in 1 horse Championships.
- High point Youth, Amateur, and Trainer will be awarded.

STALL ASSIGNMENTS

As a reminder to all attending the horse show, stall assignments are created by the Show Office. You may or may not be assigned to the same stalls as you were in previous years. The posted stall assignments are final, unless special permission is granted to change your stall assignment. If anyone is found changing stall assignments without receiving approval from the show office, they are subject to a \$100 fine per stall assignment that has been changed.

We are very sorry to have to impose this strict of a rule, however, moving just one stall assignment, without approval from the show office, can create a stall chart nightmare and if your stall has been prepared the association may be charged for it even it is not used. We appreciate everyone's cooperation and understanding.
