

TWH= Tennessee Walking Horse

SSH= Spotted Saddle Horse

BEST OF SHOW= Must have won a Blue ribbon in any of the riding classes during the show in order to enter.

Attire= Formal show apparel required.

Helmets required in all speed events and all Juvenile riders 17 and younger.

Camping arrangements must be made with the Linn County Fair and Expo Center 541-926-4314

USDA has been notified and invited to be present at our show

SHOEING REGULATIONS:

Heel and toe measurement: Toe length must not exceed the height of the heel by one inch or more. The length of the toe shall be measured from the coronary band, at the center of the front pastern along the front of the hoof wall, to the ground, including the shoe. The toe length shall not exceed 4.5 inches. The maximum allowable shoe shall not exceed 3/8 inches thickness or 3/4 width, with no bare plate or other weight inside the shoe. Caulk must not exceed 1 inch turn back and the shoe must not extend more than 1/8 beyond the hoof at the toe. The heel of the shoe must not extend beyond the bulb of the horses heel.

Hoof bands of any nature are band.

If a horse throws a shoe during the class, the rider has the option of completing the class or taking the gate. No time outs will be granted for thrown shoes.

Divisions are not defined by the shoe but by the way of moving.

No cross entries allowed between 2 gait and 3 gait classes with the same rider at the same show. (except beginning canter classes)

Exhibitors must be 18 years or older to handle, show or ride a stallion on the show grounds.

Stalls: one horse per stall.

Show management has the right to combine or cancel classes if needed.

Show office will have copy of all rules, Policies and Procedures and additional forms.
